Erector Friendly Endlaps for Standing Seam

Everyone talked about floating roofs, but few really understood the idea. Nucor did. That's why we made the endlaps on our CFR™ roof system float with thermal response. Conventional thinking said that designers had to take building expansion joints into account. If you really understand how roofing works, you know that contraction is far more important. Roof contraction means tearing of the membrane. That's why Nucor's endlap positively joins the panels together off the purlin or joists.

The unique design is also prepunched which eliminates up to seven fasteners per endlap. Fewer fasteners mean fewer parts to install and fewer to go wrong. That's right, simpler is better. Prepunched holes also mean no drill shavings. Ever read a Galvalume® warranty? Regardless of the manufacturer, they all say to remove drill shavings. Debris on the roof is one of the largest culprits of shortened roof life.

From the beginning Nucor listened to erectors who said that simpler is better. Four screws are better than 11 screws. No drill shavings means that the erector spends less time with clean up. Simpler is better. Want to hear more?
