The building also includes complete amenities for firefighters such as locker rooms, laundry, commercial kitchen and dispatch. The lower adjacent structure houses office space. The Fire hall features a large common space designed to host large meetings and annual fundraising activities.

The structure utilized a custom Nucor building with VR 16 II[™] Standing Seam roof system and Nucor Accent Wall Panels. The apparatus building has complete liner on the walls and ceiling. The project also has a 22,000 gallon reservoir under the floor for fire suppression. The exterior of the building has a 2' overhang and a valley condition where the buildings join together.
