The McKenzie Fire & Rescue Fire District protects 45 miles of Oregon's McKenzie River between Springfield and Blue River. Their crew of over 50 volunteers proudly serves their mission of preventing, protecting, and preserving life and property from loss by fire, accident, sudden illness, or disaster in the community to enhance the quality of life and to minimize suffering wherever possible.

The Leaburg Station was opened in June of 2013 replacing an outdated fire station. The new facility provides vehicle spaces for six fire engines, bunk spaces, kitchen, fitness center and shop. The building now houses all administrative offices and includes a partial mezzanine.
